First, thank you. Whether you attended Starry Starry Night or another event, volunteered your time, or supported Brightpaths financially this year, your care has helped thousands of parents and children in our community find safety, stability, and hope. You have been part of something truly special!

This year brought challenges none of us expected. Federal and state grants that once made up a large part of our budget were cut, more than \$275,000 in total. Cuts like these could have meant fewer home visits, canceled parenting classes, or families left without the support they depend on...

But that didn't happen.

Because of people like you, families continued receiving the consistent, compassionate support they needed. Parents kept learning how to build safe, stable homes. Children continued to thrive. Our services held strong because our community did too.

One mom recently shared a story that has stayed with me:

"I was in a bad spot when you came to my house. I wasn't sure how to move forward. I knew I wanted changes but I didn't know how to make them. This program has supported me to be a happy mom. I now play with my children, and my inner child comes out when we are all on the floor or outside playing. Brightpaths has been a blessing to me and my girls."

This is the heart of our work. This is the kind of transformation your support of Brightpaths makes possible.

As you read through this report, I hope you feel proud. Proud of the families who have worked so hard this year, proud of the impact you've helped create, and proud of the community we are strengthening together.

Healthy Families

Home Visiting Program

Healthy Families has been our signature program for over 30 years. As a nationally-accredited site of Healthy Families America, our highly trained home visitors serve families from birth to 5 years old with an evidence-based, strengths-based curriculum.

Brightpaths has helped me navigate some of the most difficult times of my parenthood. I don't know how I would have survived without my support through this program.

HOME VISITS IN 2025

What's in a home visit?



Home visits focus on strengthening families, connecting caregivers with resources, promoting strong parent-child attachment, coaching parents on learning activities that foster their child's development and

supporting parents' role as their child's first and most important teacher. Home visitors also conduct regular screenings to help parents identify possible health and developmental issues.



Children are assessed on several levels, given developmentally appropriate toys and activities, safe sleep kits, and other necessary support and parent education. This year, we completed 648 Ages & Stages Questionnaires (ASQ) and Social-Emotional ASQ screens, 108 Edinburgh maternal depression screens, and 92 intimate partner violence screens.

Moms who enroll in Healthy Families program prenatally experience 70% fewer pregnancy complications, leading to healthier pregnancies, safer births, higher birthweights, and more positive outcomes for our kids.

In all Healthy Families cases across the nation, first time moms who enroll in Healthy Families are 49% less likely to experience a Child Protective Services report. Furthermore, our program prevents the recurrence of child maltreatment by 33% among families who have already had CPS involvement.

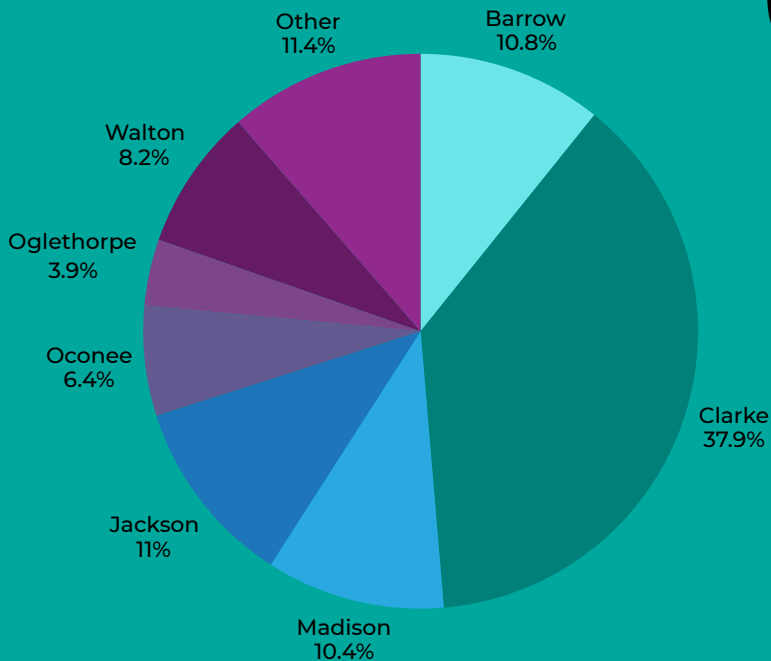


First Steps

Parent Education

Classes and Workshops

We offer classes in multiple languages and counties, both in person and virtually. Our parents work through our 10-week Nurturing Parenting Program curriculum, one-day workshops, or weekend relationship classes.

CHILDCARE GROUPS

One of this biggest barriers our parents face to getting the parenting education they want is child care. That's why we provide free childcare at every in-person class, run by trained volunteers. Our parents and kids enjoy a free meal, time to learn and connect with others.

In addition to group parenting classes and workshops, we offer individual counseling and coaching sessions for parents looking for one-on-one support as they navigate family preservation, reunification, co-parenting, or other parenting challenge.

We had the privilege of partnering with local experts like professors, community groups, and Elementary schools to offer topic specific workshops including parenting teens, special needs parenting, safety and more.

We've partnered with the University of Georgia for all 5 years of their Project F.R.E.E. Elevate grant, teaching hundreds of couples how to Elevate their relationships and create a stable foundation for their family. This year as the grant cycle ended, we were honored with several outstanding site awards.

Through our partnership with the Athens Area Diaper Bank, local donors, and individual diaper drives, we've provided over 100,000 diapers. More than just clean babies, diapers allow our kids to stay in daycare, parents to work, and families to thrive.

Our counseling clients are parents working hard to break generational cycles. The majority of them experienced abuse and Child Protective Services involvement in their own childhood, while only 28% had any sort of CPS intervention as a parent. Through our counseling program, parents are finding healing, and children are experiencing healthy childhoods.

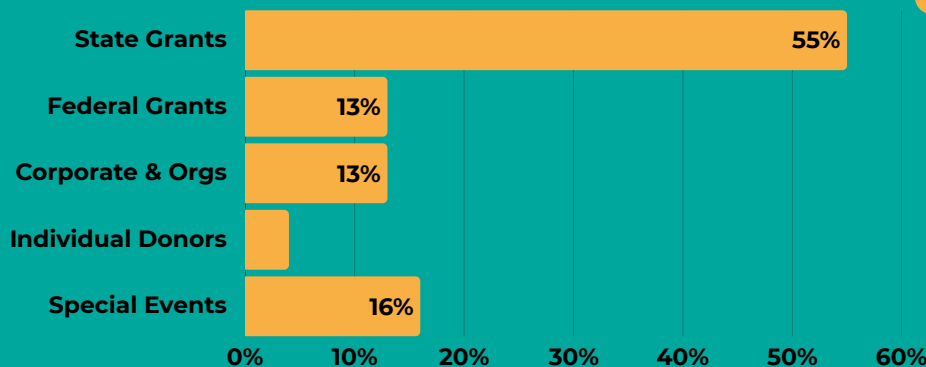

2025 Funding

This year has been tumultuous financially. Over a quarter million dollars in Federal and state grants were cut from our budget. Those reductions could have meant fewer services and put families in danger, but that didn't happen. Because of generous donors, new grants, and increased local support, we've already cut our deficit by over 50%. Our services have held strong and parents are continuing to learn how to build safe, stable homes, and local children are growing up in strong families.

The Total Direct Cost for ONE Child Maltreatment Victim's Lifetime is about \$226,822. The cost to the agency per family to participate in Healthy Families is about \$4,200 per year, making the total cost over 4 years in the program \$16,800 per family (multiple children may benefit from a single family's enrollment).
